- Stroke
- Brain injury
- Spinal cord injury
- Multi-trauma
- Multiple fractures
- Other neurologic dysfunction
- Traumatic amputations
- Post surgery
- Burns
- Congenital disorders
- Neuromuscular disorders
- Cerebral Palsy
- Pain syndromes
- Developmental disabilities
- Feeding dysfunction
- Juvenile rheumatoid arthritis

### **INPATIENT REHABILITATION CARE**

- Children will be medically managed and receive rehabilitative care by a pediatric hospitalist and a pediatric physiatrist.
- Therapy will be provided by physical, occupational and speech therapists.
- Mental health services will be provided by a psychologist.
- Pediatric-specific services will include a child-life specialist and special education teachers.
- Facility will also include: parent rooms for overnight stays, gym, activities for daily living space, recreation/child life area, parent/visitor lounge.
- Children are expected to be discharged to outpatient rehabilitation, which is offered in Good Shepherd's Health & Technology Center in Allentown and Good Shepherd Outpatient Rehabilitation – CedarPointe in South Whitehall Township.
