

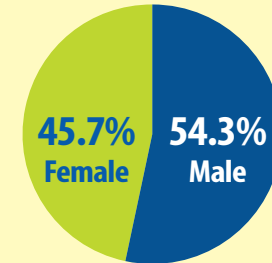
Good Shepherd Rehabilitation Hospital patients who say they met their goals in Fiscal Year 2018:

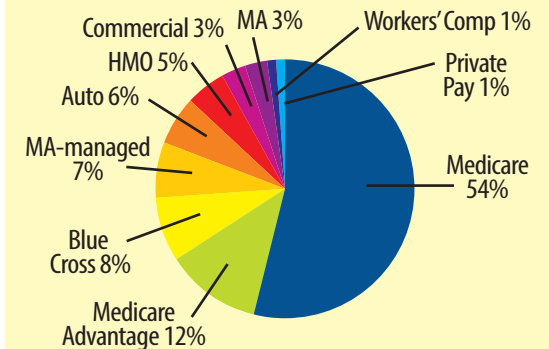


Age Group in Years
